

It was around the year 2011 that Millersville, Lock Haven, and Bloomsburg Universities began to merge under one name to form a giant union. In July 2022, these three separate universities became one under the name Commonwealth University of Pennsylvania. The school's website describes this integration as being "... a bold and forward-looking investment."

When the integration was first introduced to faculty, students, and the community at large, the school's website described this integration as being "... a bold and forward-looking investment."

The only thing that would be different under the terms of the integration is that students gain access to resources and classes provided by the other universities under the common understanding that they are under the association of Commonwealth University.

They were told each university would retain their names, culture, and community. This promise has been slowly becoming false with actions that have occurred in the past few weeks.

University websites have been updated to one centralized website, under the Commonwealth University name. Faculty staff have been put in joint emails with the faculty staff of the other individual universities regarding them as a whole.

Last week, students were locked out of their emails with little to no warning in advance. On top of this, they were confused as to why. Was it a security issue? Or was Microsoft just having a bad day? It was shortly revealed after that students' emails had been changed to the general email of commonwealth.edu.

While this may seem convenient in the sense that some students are taking classes at the other campus it also has proved to be issues. With this happening the week before the start of Spring Semester and the end of the Winter Term, students were given with a little extra stress to well come them back for the New Year.

Students were not locked out of their emails, but their access to their emails was cut off. In addition, professors were given four different emails. One for each of the 3 campuses, and the Commonwealth University as a whole. The emails for the three individual campuses (this is the main Commonwealth University email).

This can potentially pose issues and confusion in communication as a result of having direct and indirect communication. Like when you need to email someone, you have to go into a series of situations and before you are even to the professor. The university has used related information on how to fix email issues. First, it was released as an answer to a forum story and later links were sent through the student wide communication system only days before they were expected to move classes.

Overall people feel very hurt by the situation. When presented, the integration was it was a glorified light by all the potential opportunities it offered. When concerns were presented, they were brushed with the idea that nothing was really going to change. There was only positivity because from the decision to each individual, everyone would be able to reach their goals.

Many people have how feel deceived and if the integration was avoided after on campus that have been taking classes that were once had the same level of quality with a blanket of generalization causing the communication to only state the best and ignore the worst.

The solar energy initiative allows Bloomsburg Carpet to significantly reduce its carbon footprint and invest in a more sustainable future. Bloomsburg Carpet also partnered

with the county conservation district to improve stream quality and surrounding wildlife on the land next to the carpet mill. An existing structure on this land was restored and repurposed as the Bloomsburg Carpet Factory Outlet. The outlet at 4012 Wolf Hollow Road sells discounted rugs in standard sizes created from carpet remnants in the mill.
